Allegra Goodman is the author of *Intuition*, *Paradise Park*, *Kaaterskill Falls*, *The Family Markowitz*, and *Total Immersion*. *The Other Side of the Island* is her first book for younger readers. Her fiction has appeared in *The New Yorker*, *Commentary*, and *Ploughshares*, *Prize Stories: the O. Henry Awards and Best American Short Stories*. Her essays and reviews have appeared in *The New York Times Book Review*, *The New Republic*, *The Boston Globe*, and *The American Scholar*. Raised in Honolulu, Goodman studied English and philosophy at Harvard and received a PhD in English literature from Stanford. She is the recipient of a Whiting Writer's Award, the Salon Award for Fiction, and a fellowship from the Radcliffe Institute for Advanced study. She lives with her family in Cambridge, Mass, where she is writing a new novel.
